## *High Power Update 2011*

There will again be 12 matches at BCSA, Tioga, Sayre and Square Deal

Entry fee is a one- time per year league fee of \$15 (\$7.50 for juniors - 20th birthday this year, or younger) and \$10 (\$5 for juniors.) fee per match entered. The league fee is payable along with the match fee the first time you shoot. Non-league shooters are welcome to shoot for "score-only", per match fees \$15 (\$7.50 for juniors) Special 1-time, non-league fee of \$5 for a new shooter. Joining the league makes you eligible for prize money at end of the season.

This year we are trying something new. We will allow shooters interested in shooting matches with a 22 rim fire. Rim fire shooters will shoot the same rules, distance and targets as the high power shooters. Rim fire will not be counted as league scores, and no prizes will be awarded.

This is an opportunity for people to try shooting the matches without the expense of high power equipment and ammunition. Rim fire shooters will be admitted only after all high power shooters are squadded. There are usually a lot of openings on the afternoon relay. There will be no league fees or prizes for rim fire, and only a \$5.00 fee for targets. You should definitely call before the match to make sure there are openings.

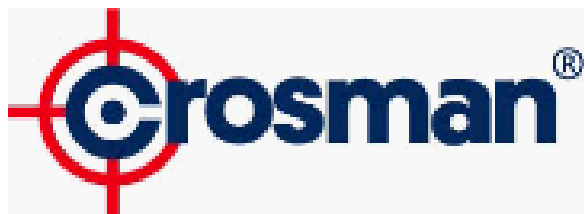
